How many of these items do you already have? We've tried to keep it simple for you by making the majority of the items things most people have within reach (both physically and budget-wise)

- 2-liter bottle caps, 8
- 2-liter soda bottles, 10 (empty and clean)
- belt buckle (or large, strong rubber bands)
- cardboard
- coins, 2
- compost or organic food/scrap
- cotton ball
- cutting board
- dish
- drill (with adult help)
- flowers
- gravel or sand
- ice
- knife (sharp, with adult help)
- lettuce or celery
- light bulbs (colored)
- microscope with slides
- newspaper
- paper
- plants
- plastic lid (that fits inside a soda bottle)
- plastic tubing, 2 pieces (stiff)
- predators (spiders OR praying mantis OR carnivorous plants)
- razor (with adult help)
- rubber tubing, 1-2 feet (flexible)
- ruler
- scissors
- seeds of fast-growing plants (radish, grass, turnips, moss, etc.)
- soil
- soil, twigs, small plants
- Spanish moss
- string (60 cm, heavy cotton)
- tape
- test tube with stopper (or small vial)
- water
- wire mesh, fine
