How many of these items do you already have? We've tried to keep it simple for you by making the majority of the items things most people have within reach (both physically and budget-wise).

- 2-liter soda bottles, 4 (empty and clean)
- bottle caps, 2 (for 2-liter bottles)
- broccoli
- broom handles, 2
- coins, 2 (different ones)
- cotton ball
- duct tape
- film canister (or similar small container)
- fine wire mesh (very small gauge)
- flexible rubber tubing (1-2 feet)
- fly-wire screen netting (1m x 2 meters, 0.6 gauge)
- hammer
- heavy canvas, 4 strips (20 cm x 1 m)
- iron
- ironing board
- items to sort (such as various buttons, coins, plant leaves, nuts, etc.)
- nails
- paper
- pen
- plant (not potted)
- plastic container (with snap lid, like an M&M container)
- plastic lid (that fits inside a soda bottle)
- pot with soil
- predators (spiders OR praying mantis OR carnivorous plants)
- razor (with adult help)
- ruler
- scale
- scissors
- sewing machine
- small piece of fruit
- soil, twigs, small plants
- stiff plastic tubing, 2 pieces (short)
- stove (with adult help)
- tape
- thread
- vial or test tube with 2-holed rubber stopper (snug fitting!)
- water
