- 2-liter soda bottle (with lid)
- 3' string
- 3/4" pipe foam insulation (NOT neoprene and NOT the kind with built-in adhesive)
- balloon, 7-9 inches
- bicycle pump
- car tire valve
- CD (an old one)
- clothespin, wood
- drill (with adult help)
- drinking straw
- hair dryer
- hot glue gun
- hot water
- ice water
- index cards
- marbles
- masking tape
- paper
- pencil (sharp tip)
- ping pong ball (or wadded up foil or marshmallow)
- popsicle sticks, large (tongue depressor sized)
- razor (with adult help)
- rubber bands, (wide - at least 1/4")
- rubbing alcohol
- ruler
- scissors
- short dowel or cardboard tube from coat hanger
- spoon, plastic
- tape
- thumbtack
- towel
- water
- water bottle with sport lid
- wooden skewer or dowel
